Reverse on Any Color

To maintain the integrity of the logo, it should not be placed on patterned or textured backgrounds, and should not appear with a white box behind it.

## Exclusion Zone

To maximize visual presence, the logo requires a surrounding area clear of any other graphic elements or text. The minimum exclustion zone is equal to the width of the " M " in Missouri. This way the exclusion zone is relevant to the size of the logo.
